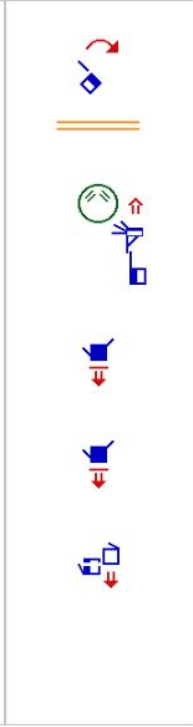
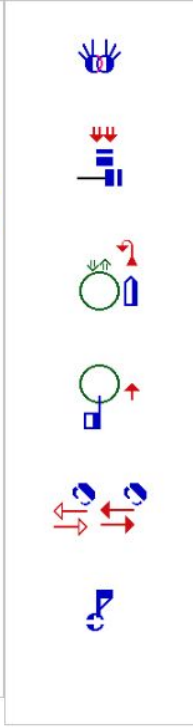
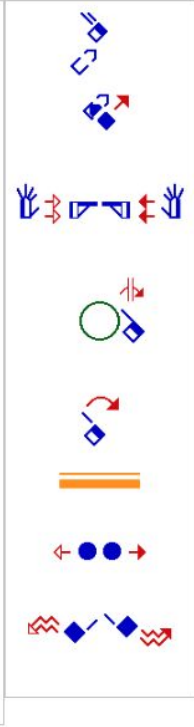
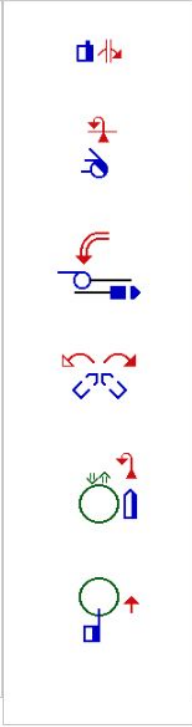
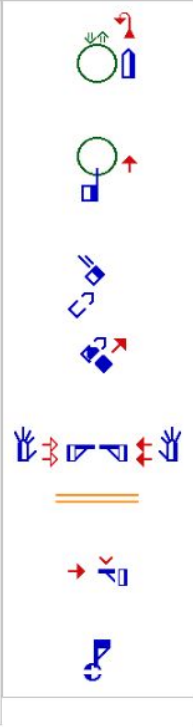
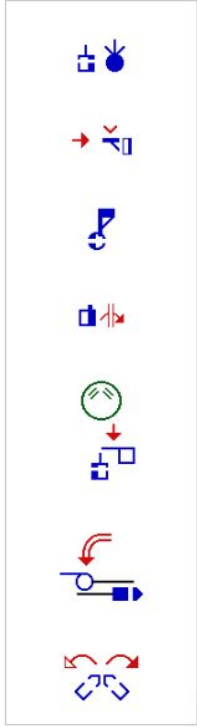


14And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.



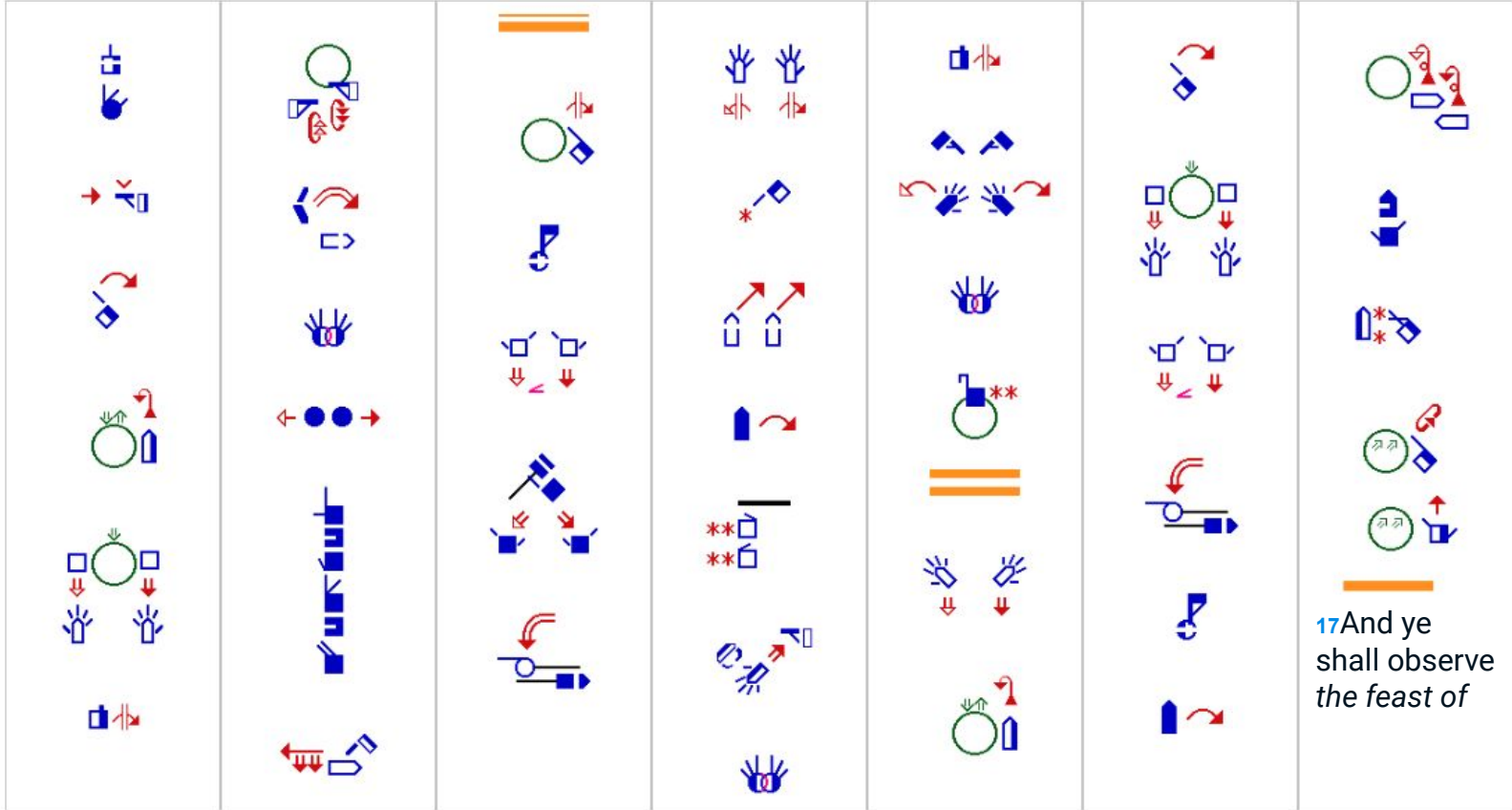
15 Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall

put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.



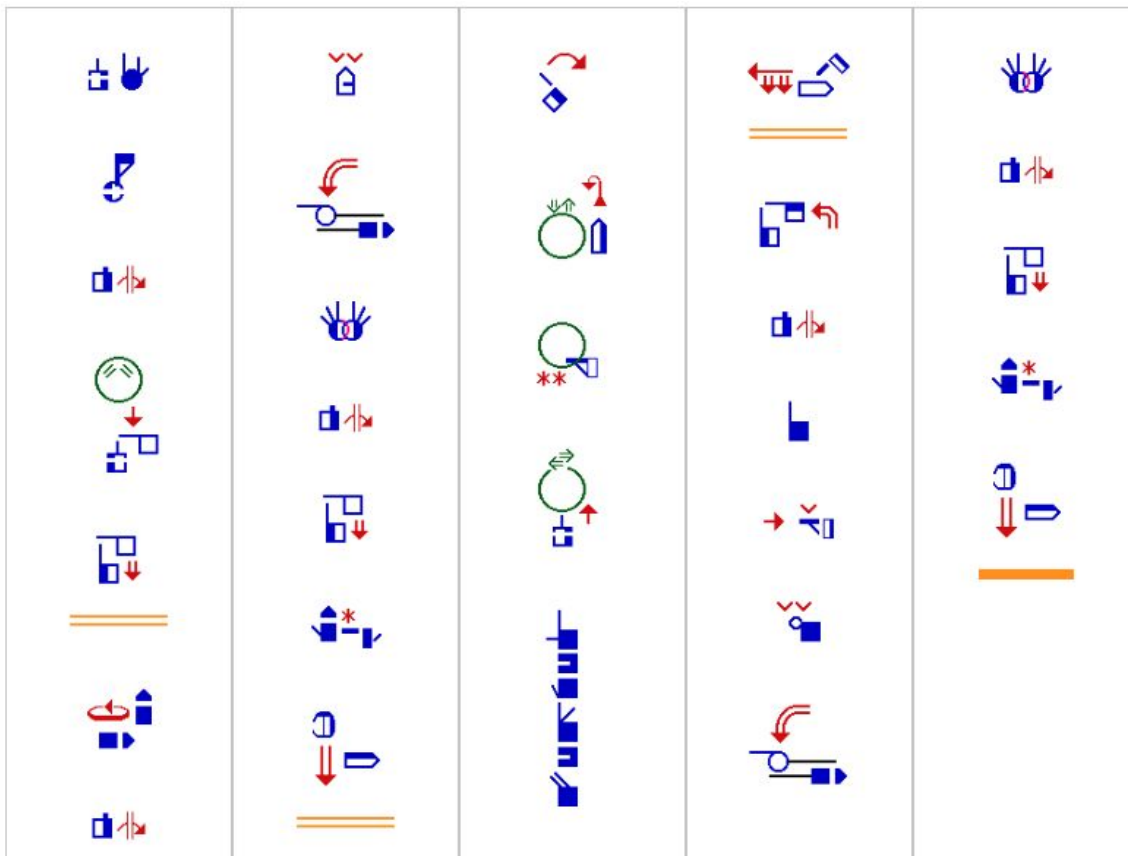
the seventh day there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man must eat, that only may be done of you.

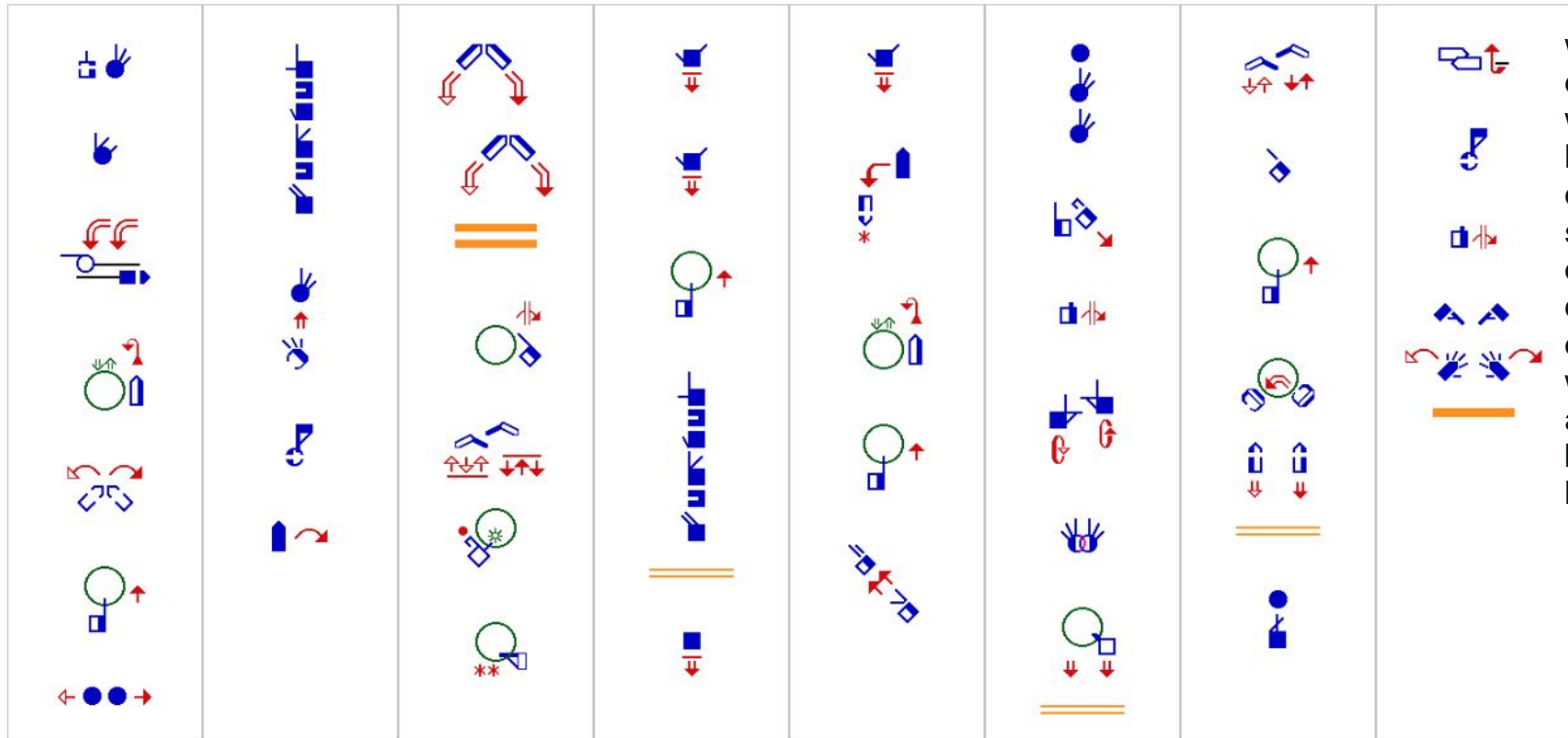


17And ye shall observe the feast of

unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever.

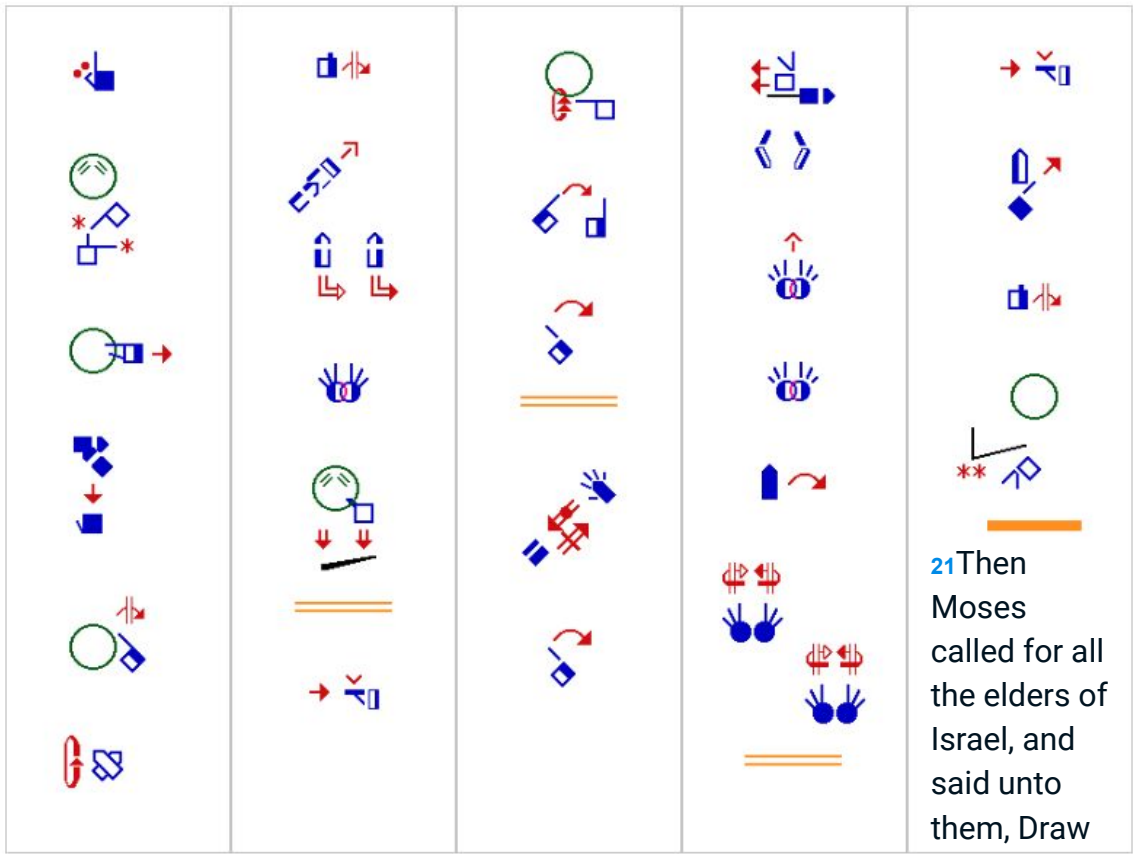


18 In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even.

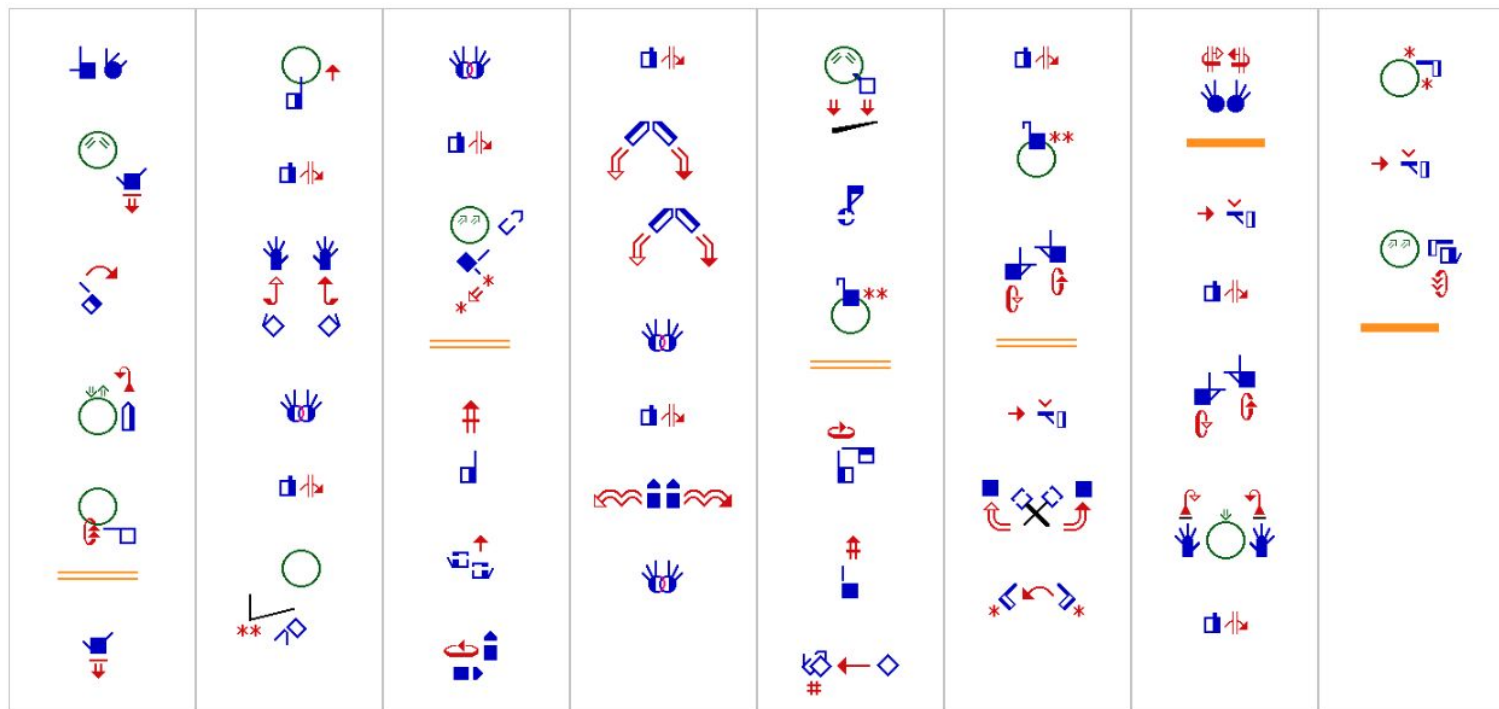
24 And ye shall observe this thing for an ordinance to thee and to thy sons for ever.



25 And it shall come to pass, when ye be come to the land which the LORD will give you, according as he hath promised, that ye shall keep this service.

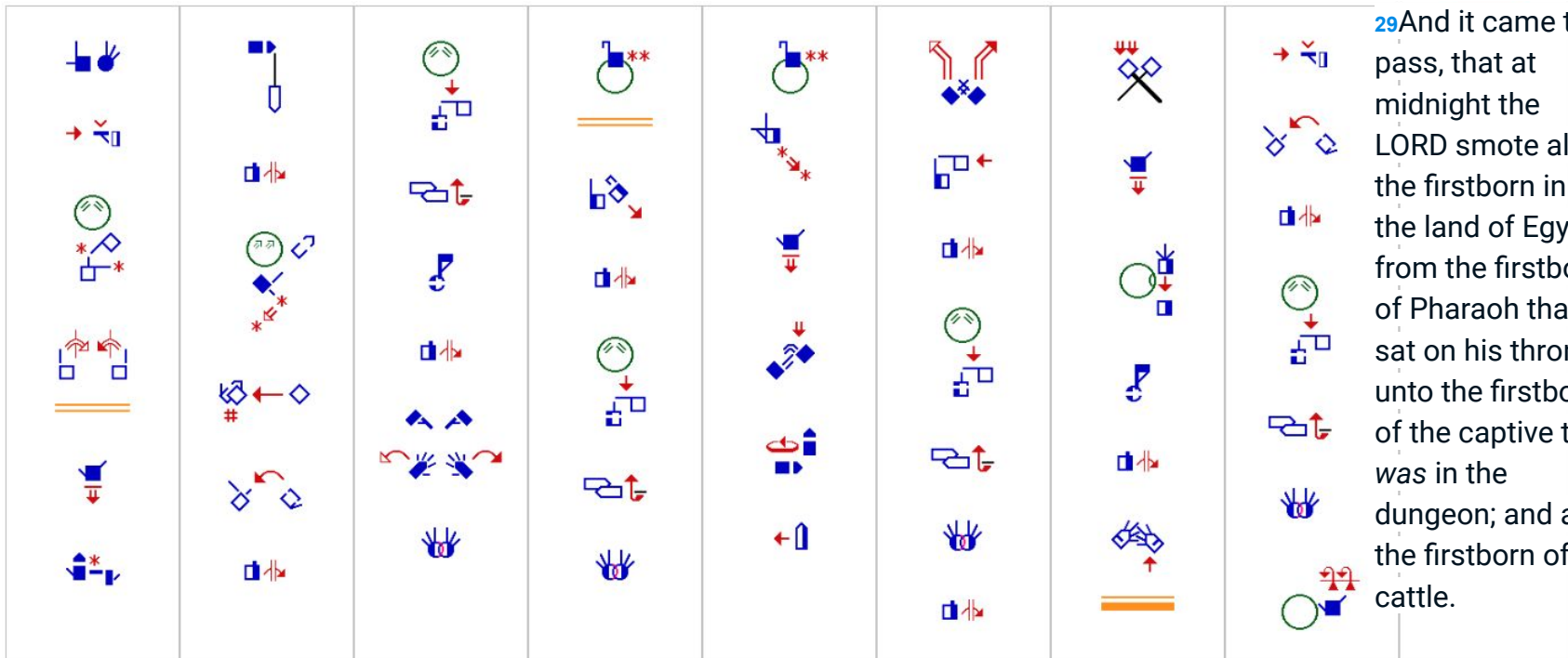


26 And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, What mean ye by this service?

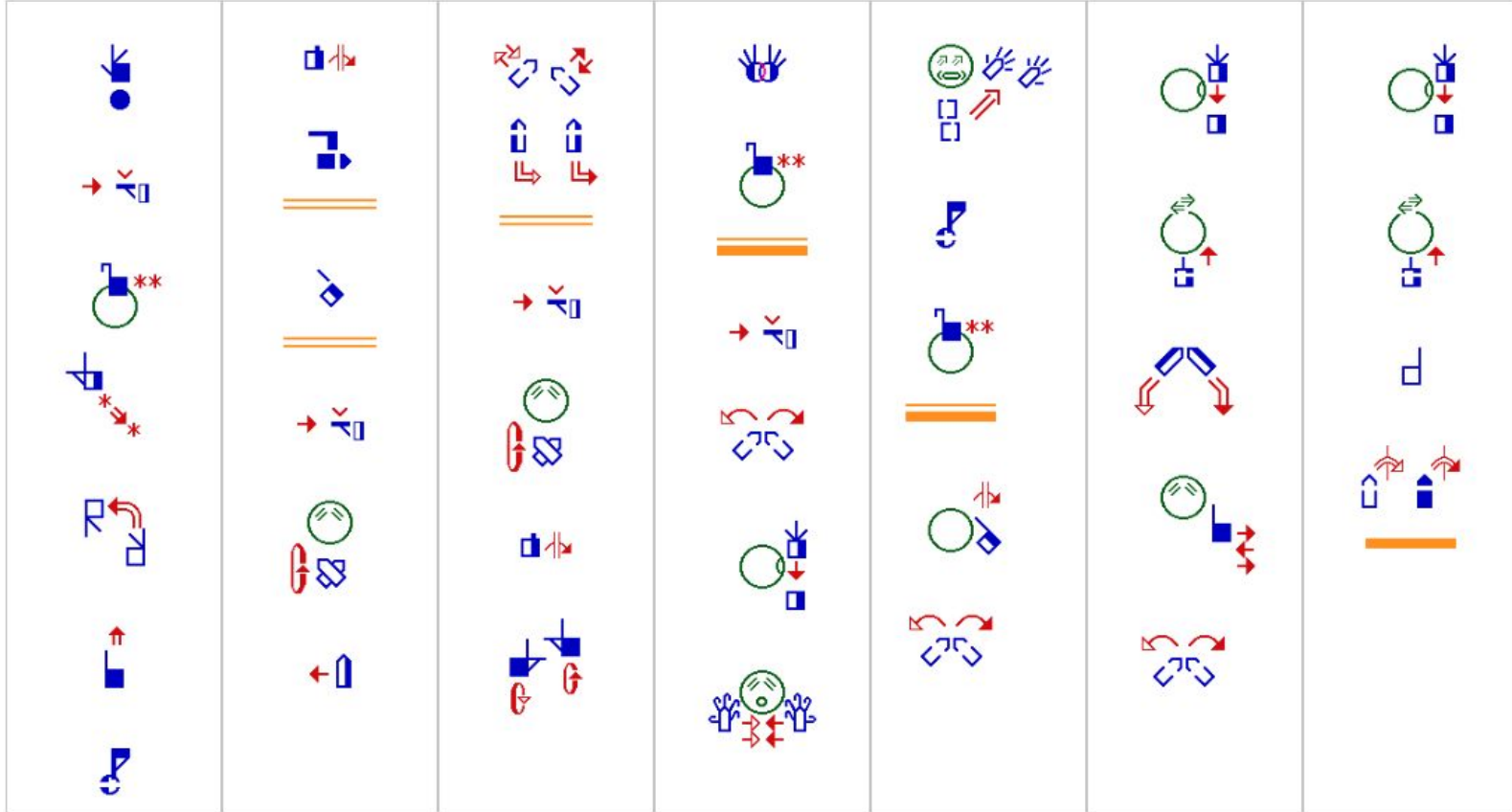

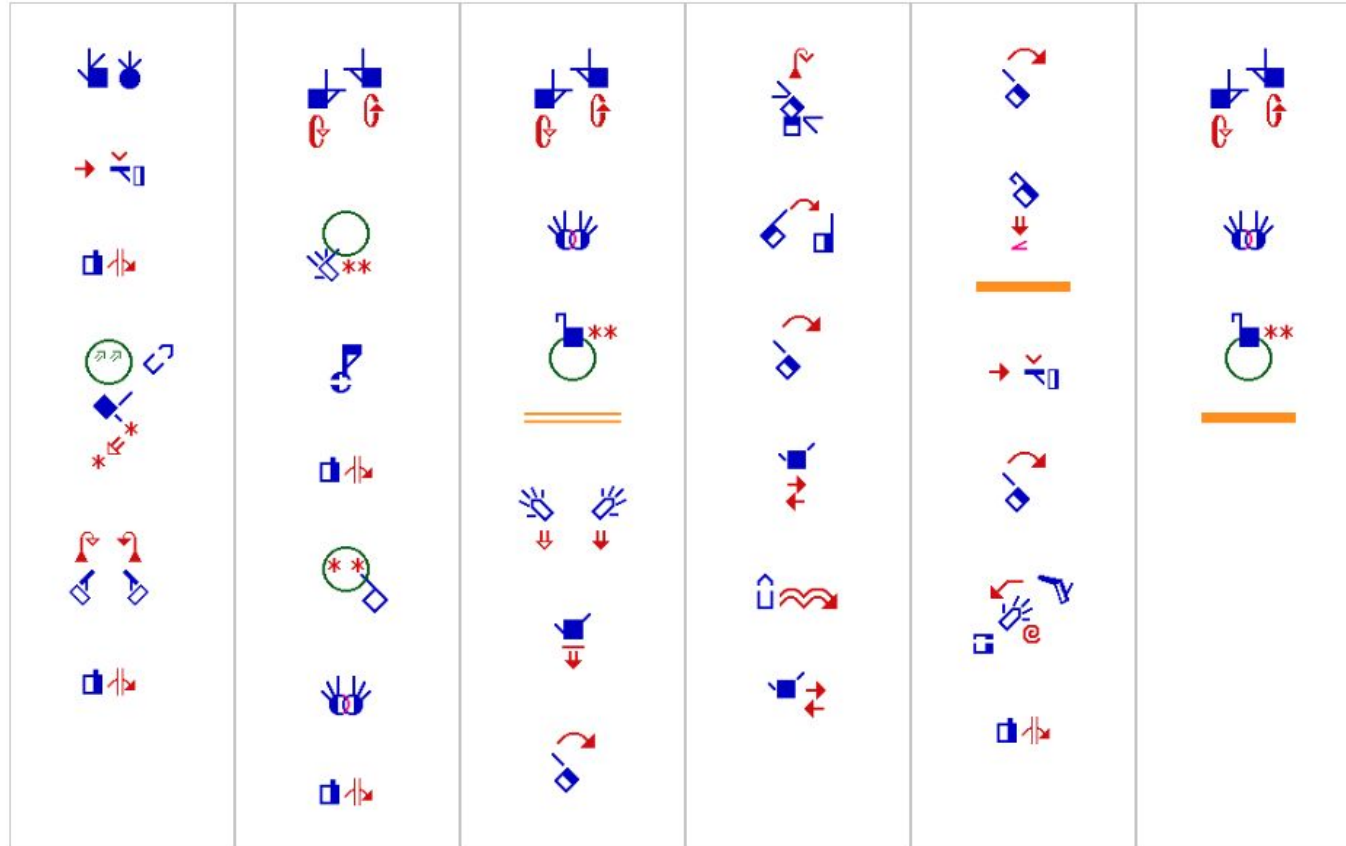

31Then he summoned Moses and Aaron by night and said, "Up, go out from among my people, both you and the people of Israel; and go, serve the LORD, as you have said."



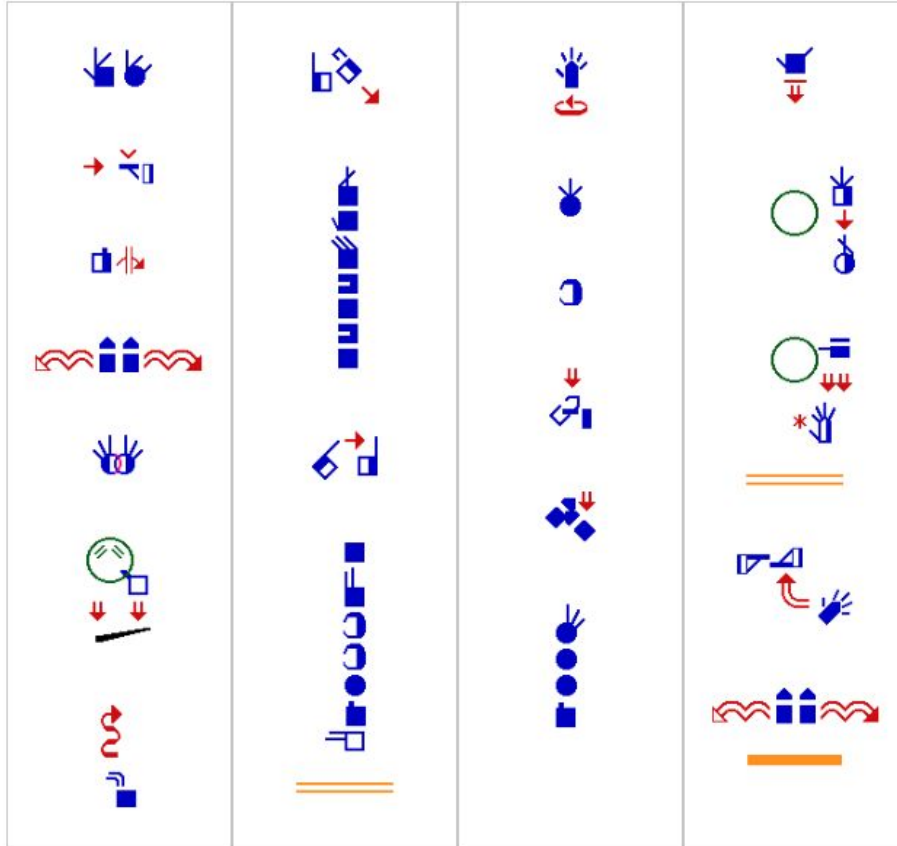

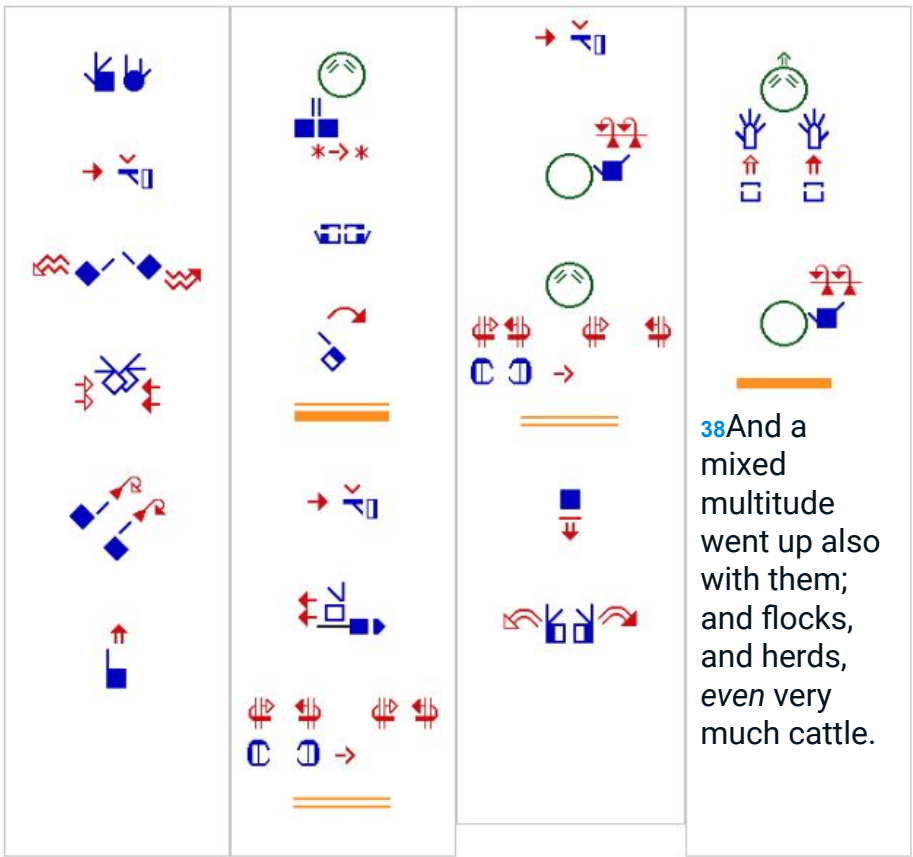

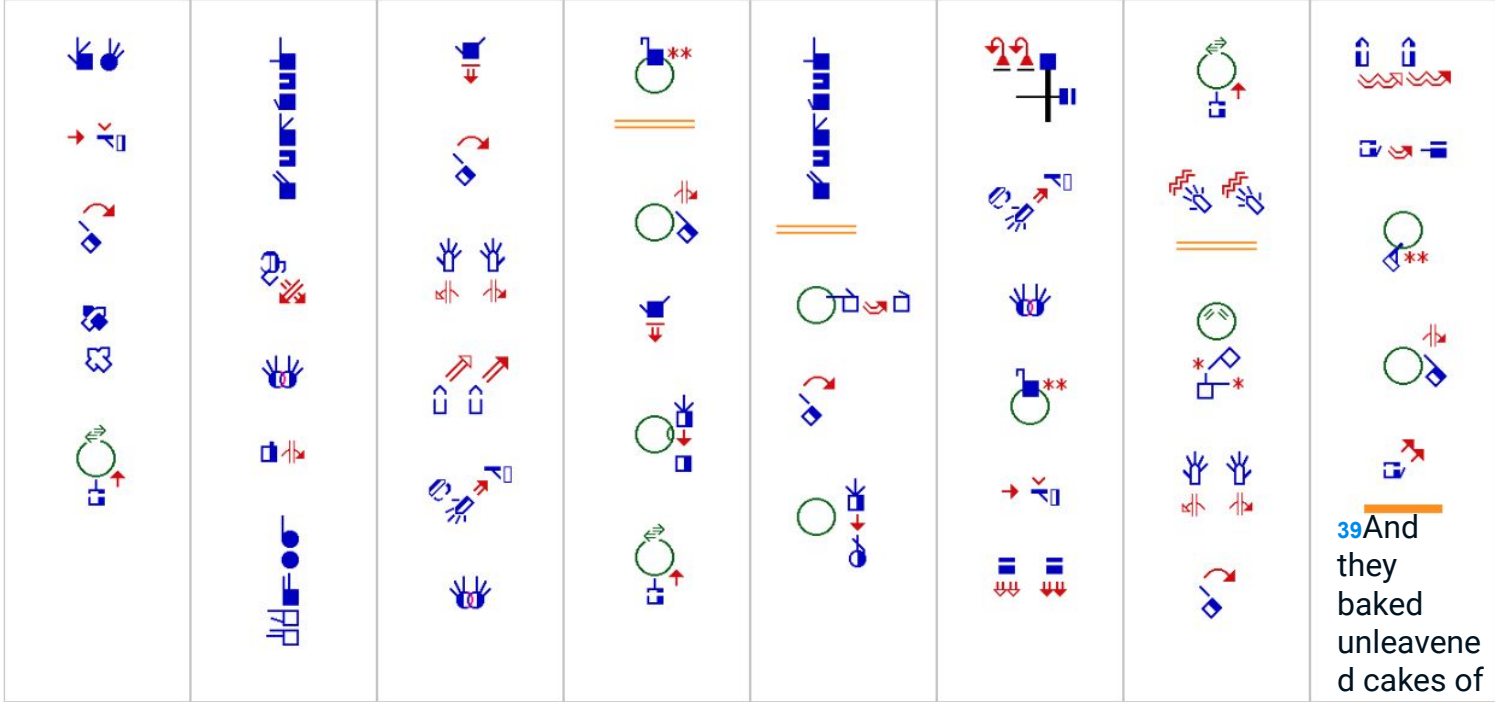


36 And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them *such things as they required*. And they spoiled the Egyptians.



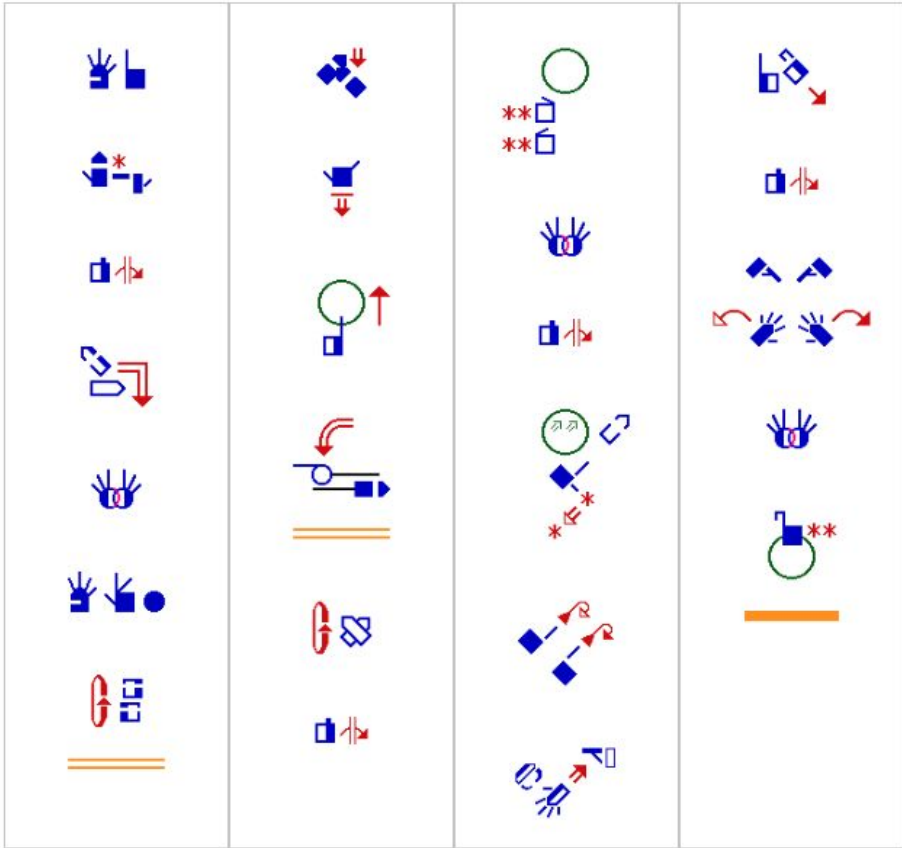
37And the children of Israel journeyed from Rameses to Succoth, about six hundred thousand on foot *that* were men, beside children.



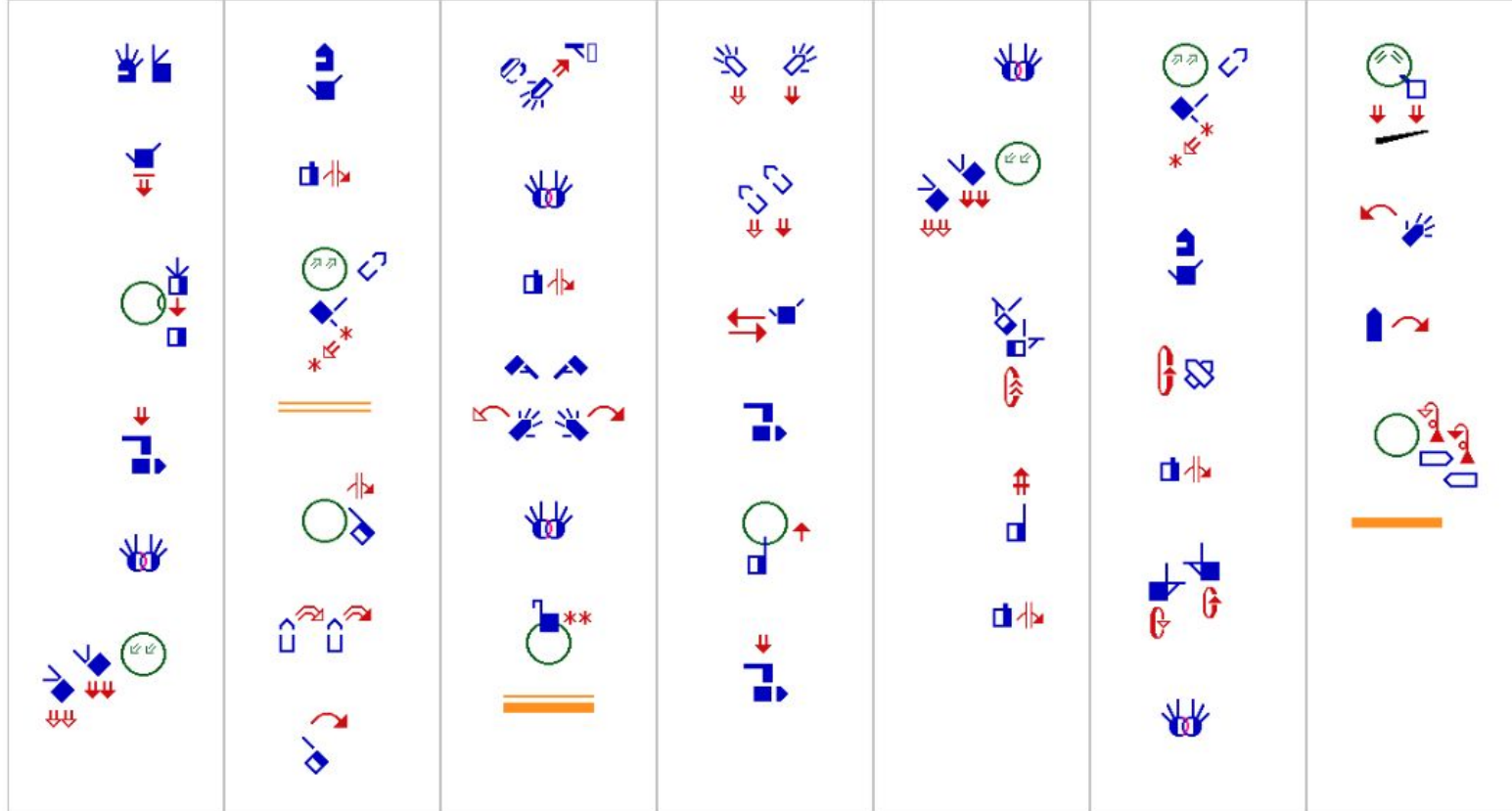

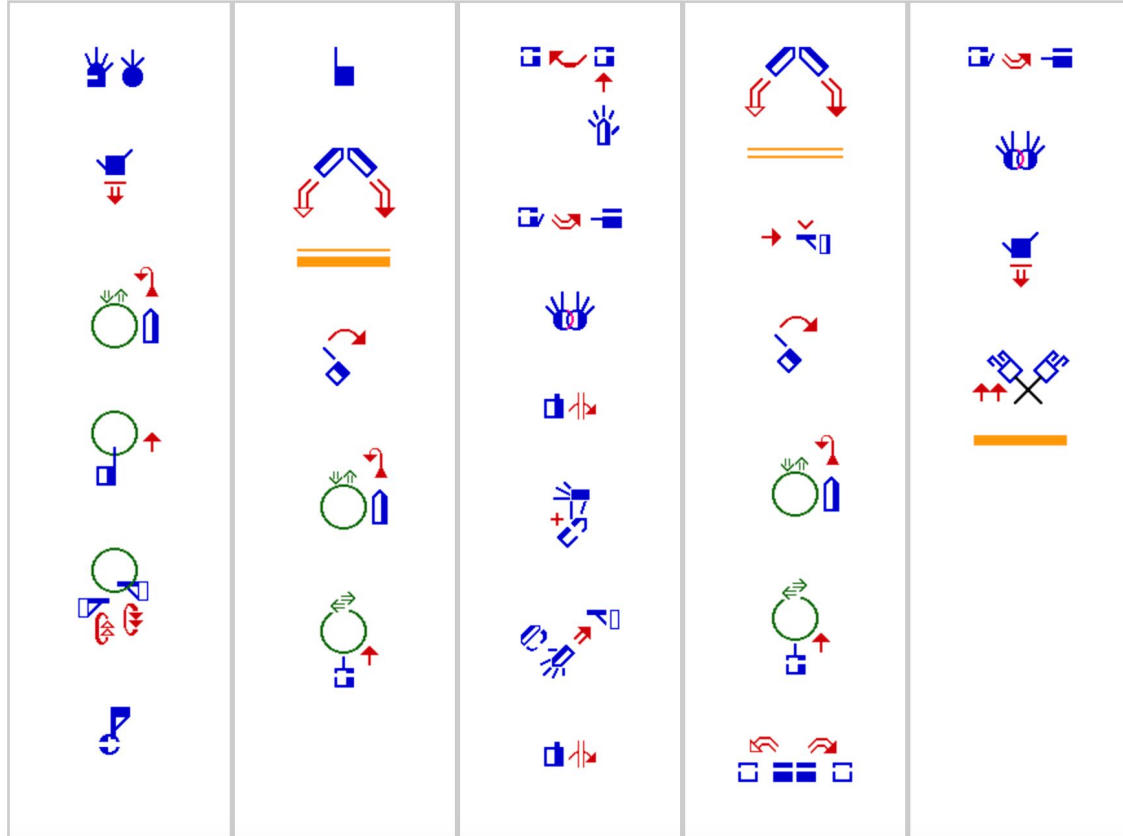


43And the LORD said to Moses and Aaron, "This is the statute of the Passover: no foreigner shall eat of it,

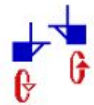


44but every slave that is bought for money may eat of it after you have circumcised him.

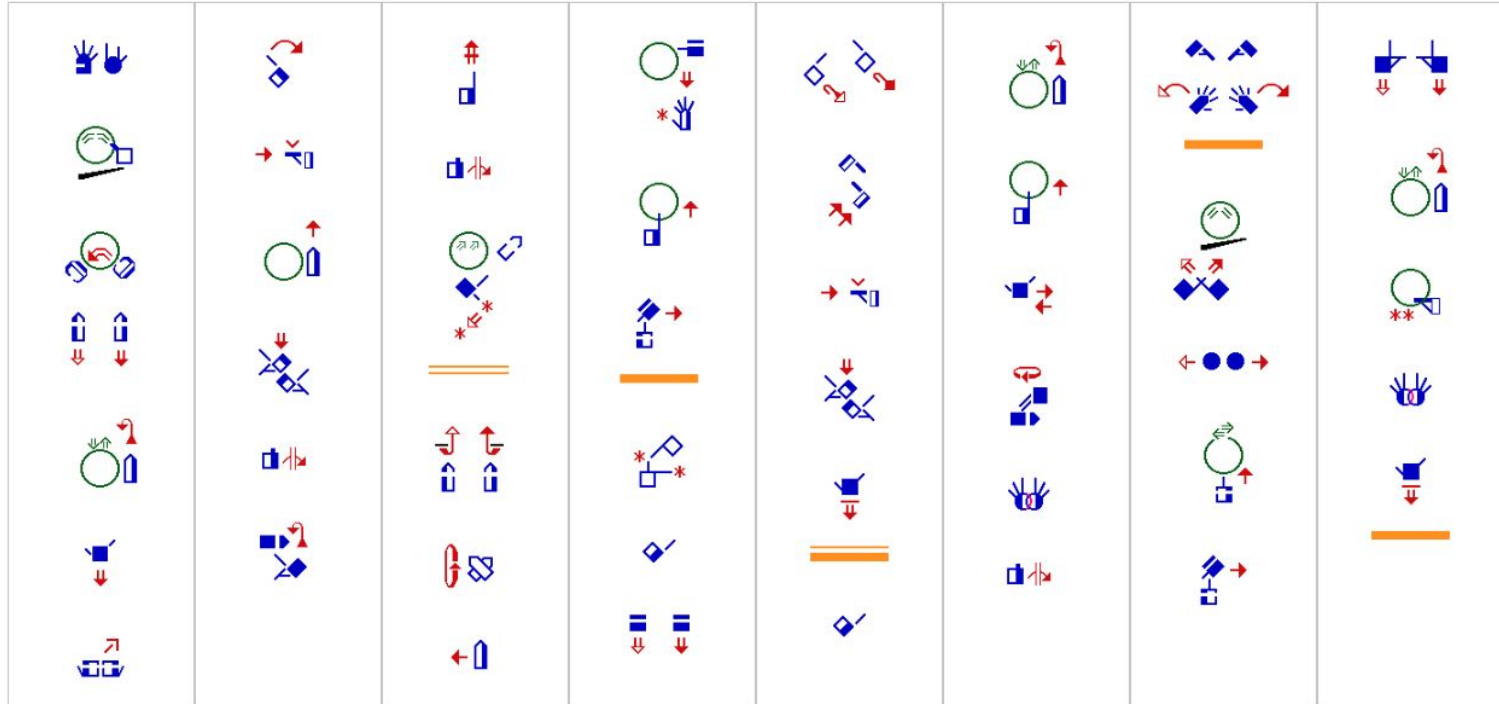

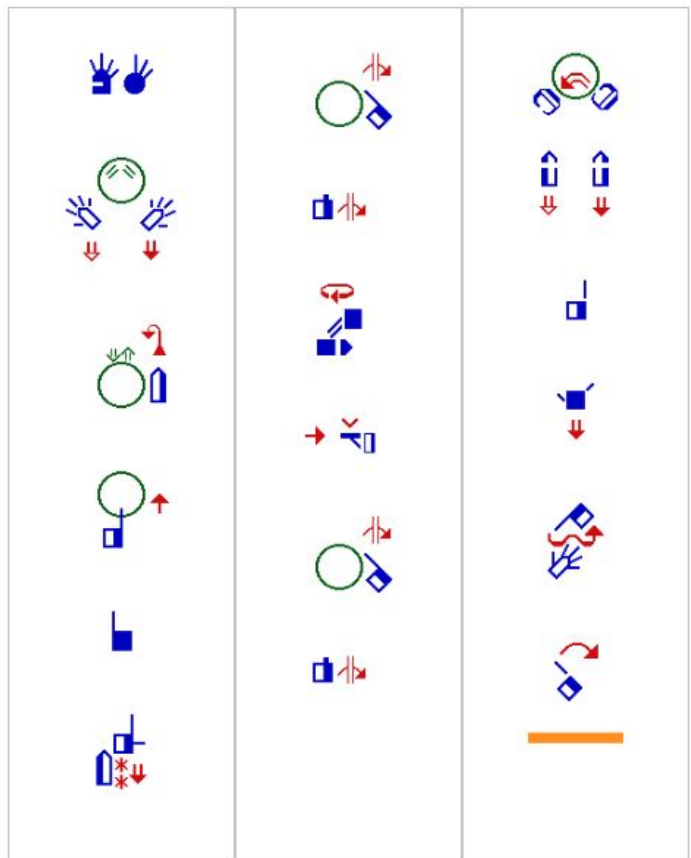
46It shall be eaten in one house; you shall not take any of the flesh outside the house, and you shall not break any of its bones.



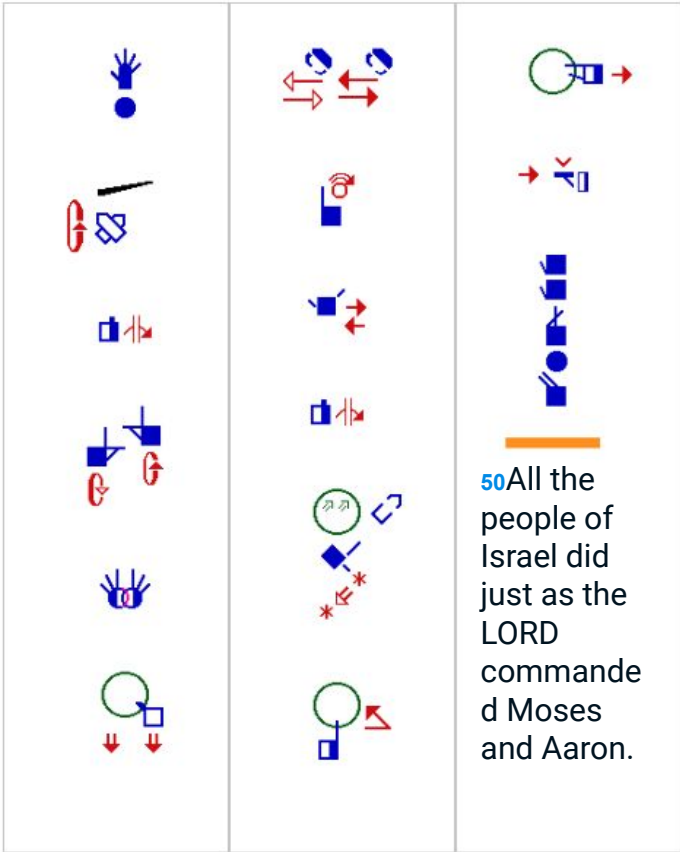
47All the congregation of Israel shall keep it.

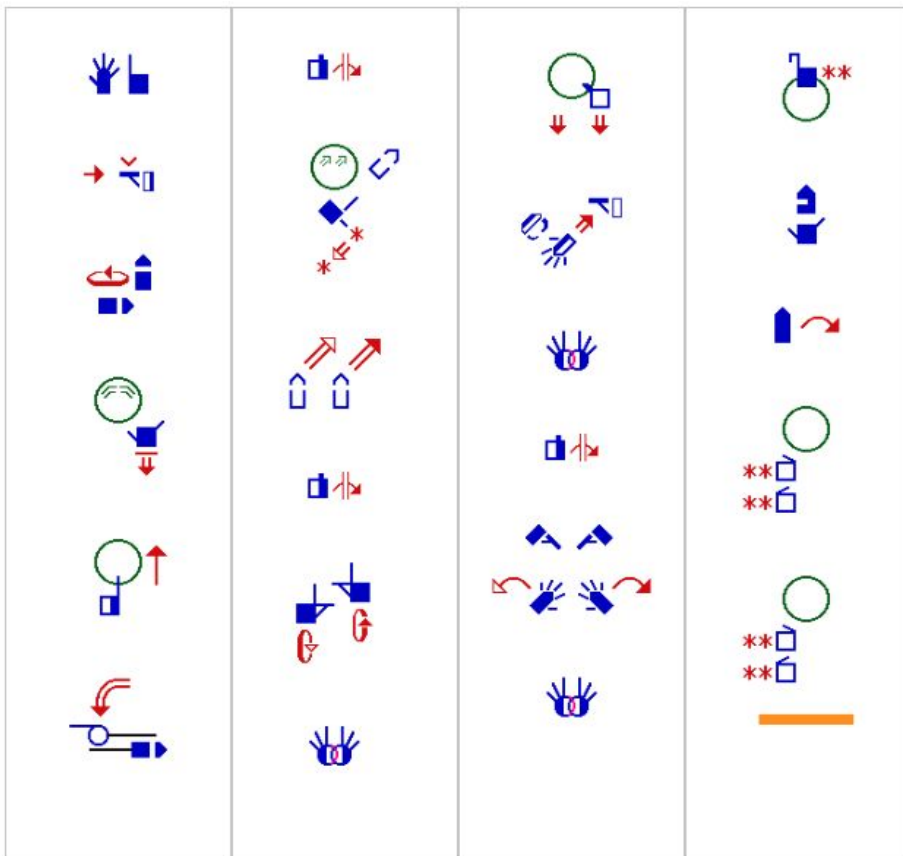
