

LetraSinal: An Attempt at a Google Docs for SignWriting

LetraSinal is a web text editor heavily modeled after Google Docs, taking inspiration from Delegs and SignPuddle 2.

LetraSinal began as a playful project to practice web application development skills, initially aimed at learning how to incorporate Sutton SignWriting into websites.

However, after the developer introduced the application to the Brazilian Deaf Authors community and familiarized himself with the latest code libraries developed by Steve Slevinski – the creator of SignPuddle, it evolved into a nearly completed text editor.

In this presentation, the developer discusses the motivations behind the project, the ease of developing applications with Sutton SignWriting so that you may develop your own, the current state of the project, and future goals.
